

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
JANUARY 3, 2023

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Tuesday, January 3, 2023 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of December 27, 2022 as submitted. Motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of calendar year 2023 Board of Supervisors appointments of Chairman, Vice-Chair and to various boards and committees as submitted. Motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding Keokuk County Highway Department.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded approval of resolution designating County Engineer to execute on behalf of Keokuk County for Farm to Market projects as submitted. Motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of resolution naming county employees to issue and sign special permits for vehicles of excessive size and weight for the county as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded approval of resolution naming county employees to temporary closing of roadways as submitted. Motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to authorize approval of 28E sharing agreement for purchase and maintenance of Weiler 430B road widener upon review of agreement once received. Motion carried. This is a dedicated shouldering machine of which is proposed to be split evenly between Keokuk, Mahaska, Washington, Henry, Lee and Clinton counties, totaling \$41,086 each.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded approval of January 3, 2023 claims as submitted. Motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of Keokuk County Medical Examiner, Associate Medical Examiner, Medical Investigators and Reserve Medical Investigator appointments for calendar year 2023 as submitted. Motion carried.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to set the time, date and place for public hearing regarding proposed fiscal year 2023 Keokuk County Budget amendment as January 23, 2023 at 9:30 a.m. in the Boardroom. Motion carried.

Hadley moved, Snakenberg seconded approval regarding re-appointment of Jerlyn Bowers, RN to the Board of Health for a three-year term as submitted. Motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports was held. Hadley attended a Board of Health meeting. Neither Wood or Snakenberg had meetings to attend last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Bates informed the proposed departmental budget requests will be prepared for review next Monday.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:30 a.m.
