Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes for September 3, 2024 as submitted. Hadley abstained due to being absent for said meeting. Motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of personnel report for resignation of Jacob Butler, full-time, Sheriff's Department as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Thomas Bean, Land & Liberty Coalition representative, entered the Boardroom requesting to discuss wind and solar energy.

Met with Jerry Wohler to discuss pavilion project grant. Hadley moved to provide a letter of support on behalf of the pavilion project due to the majority vote in 2021 was in support of the pavilion. Roll call vote: Ayes – Hadley, Wood; Nay – Snakenberg. Motion passed.

Various Board and Committee reports were held. Snakenberg participated in a Decat meeting. Hadley attended an Area 15 meeting the week prior. Wood had no scheduled meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. No additional topics were discussed.
