

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
NOVEMBER 12, 2024

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Tuesday, November 12, 2024, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Fred Snakenberg and Christy Bates, Auditor.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes for November 4, 2024 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department as follows: wet weather has been reflected on several roads in Keokuk County, in particular complaints were received regarding the Harper and Ollie regrade project areas, that have received rock to help rectify the issue.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of personnel report for Colten Altenhofen to fill the General Working Foreman position as submitted due to operating experience in the field. All ayes and motion carried. Altenhofen will continue to maintain the Kinross route until that position is filled.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded approval of personnel report for hire of Autumn Anderson, full-time dispatcher/jailer with starting date as November 12, 2024 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Jenny Thompson regarding Sigourney Hometown Holiday Festival Committee would like to bring in an old pickup to decorate and leave in the courtyard over the holiday season. Their goal is to raise funds to refurbish or replace the historical Santa as well. Board consensus was to allow said request. The Holiday Festival will be held on November 30, 2024.

Various Board and Committee reports were held. Wood attended 1015 Transit and Pathfinders meetings. Snakenberg stated the Decat meeting was cancelled. Hadley had no scheduled meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Bates informed of a DNR construction permit variation requesting approval or disapproval recommendation, although Keokuk County does not participate in the master matrix and therefore does not necessitate a recommendation. Bates will contact DNR and report back.

Official Canvass of November 5, 2024 Keokuk County General Election was held with those present. No changes were made to the unofficial results.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 11:40 a.m.
