Review of Keokuk County Sheriff FY2026 budget requests was held with Casey Hinnah.

Various Board and Committee reports were held. Wood attended the Boost meeting at Keokuk County Economic Development (KCED). Weber attended the ISAC Statewide Supervisors meeting. Hadley attended Sieda, Area 15, Regional Economic Development Investment (REDI), KCED Loan Committee and also attended the ISAC Statewide Supervisors meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. DeJong Lawn Care sent a quote for \$960 for courtyard care. Board consensus was to approve this service. Bates reported the dog “dumping” area has been rectified by Sigourney Code Enforcement Officer Glandon and Don Arduser has agreed to mow the recycling center again this year. Sigourney Mayor Morlan was present to discuss requirement use of the recycling center to share with City Council members.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:45 a.m.
