Christy Bates reported the dog “dumping” area has been rectified by Doug Glandon, Sigourney Code Enforcement Officer and Don Arduser has agreed to mow the recycling center again this year. Jim Morlan, Sigourney Mayor, was present to discuss requirement use of the recycling center to share with City Council members.
