9:40 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. The proposed property tax notice will be published in the March 12th News-Review and a letter will be sent out to property owners on or prior to March 15, 2025. Cunningham maintenance established a new motor and board is needed for the outdoor HVAC system two unit that will be covered by warranty. Atwood Electric electrician traced the loss of power to low voltage of the generator. Ace Electric was contacted to check the generator.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:50 a.m.
