9:05 a.m. – Discussion regarding Mental Health Advocate transition. As per the Iowa Department of Health & Human Services (HHS) Division of Behavioral Health & Disability Services guidance, mental health advocates continue to be appointed by the county board of supervisors. Christy Bates is requesting approval to reach out to the current advocate to inquire of interest in continuing service on behalf of Keokuk County. Board consensus was to proceed with the inquiry and process thereof.

9:10 a.m. - Various Board and Committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended a RUSS meeting. Kevin Weber participated in a Decat meeting. Mike Hadley had no meeting last week.

9:12 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Pie Reighard, Conservation Director, was present to inform a sizeable dock project will be starting soon at Belva Deer. Lucas Meier reviewed Conference Board meeting discussion. Proposed property tax notices were inadvertently sent

out by the mailer for 2024-2025 followed by correct notices for 2025-2026 prior to the mandated legislative deadline of March 15, 2025.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:30 a.m.
