The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, June 9, 2025, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agenda as amended to include Approval of Mental Health Advocate MOU with Des Moines County. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Casey Jarmes, News Review, was present.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the minutes of June 2, 2025 as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.
