Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of personnel report regarding Emma Hammes, part-time Jailer/Dispatcher, Sheriff’s Department as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Weber seconded approval of personnel report regarding resignation of Amber Thompson, Keokuk County Attorney’s Office, as of July 1, 2025 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of Fiscal Year 2026 Appropriations Resolution as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports were held. Wood attended 1015 Transit, RPA 15 Policy Board and KCED strategic grant meetings. Hadley attended Board of Health and Semco (financial) meetings. Weber had no scheduled meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Zach with Cunninham determined the condensate pump was not keeping up and recommended a larger pump. Board consensus was to have a new pump installed. Heidi Baker, 8<sup>th</sup> District Court Administrator, placed a quad desk set up in the Clerk of Court’s office that will require a direct wire. Board consensus was the outlet placement was agreed upon during the electrical project and this additional outlet would be a state cost. Wood reminded the county needs to remove the mental health furniture out of the Community Outreach Center. Bates will contact Tami Gilliland for entry access.

Hadley adjourned there being no further business until 4:15 p.m. – Cash Count.

Weber moved, Wood seconded to readjourn the meeting. Hadley was absent. Motion carried.

Wood moved, Weber seconded certification of accurate account of cash count of monies reported by County Recorder and Treasurer’s Offices for end of fiscal year 2025 as submitted. Motion carried.

On vote and motion Wood adjourned the meeting at 4:30 p.m.
