Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Sanders, Assessor/GIS was present to inform he received a street view only quote from Google NC Tech but felt it was designed for urban areas and not useful for rural areas. Hadley brought up tax figures showing on Beacon prior to the process being completed. Sanders responded this had not happened previously and felt it was a Tyler issue since Beacon pulls the information from Tyler.
