

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
AUGUST 11, 2025

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, July 28, 2025, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Weber moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. Casey Jarmes, News Review was present.

Wood moved, Weber seconded to approve the minutes of August 4, 2025 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding Keokuk County Highway department was held as follows: no update from DeLong Construction regarding the V45 project; the grant application has been submitted for the bridge north of Richland; regrading/ditching near Gibson; the Hayesville preconstruction will be held this week; and application for CHBP funding for Bond Hill Park bridge on W15 and a bridge on the Fremont Road is being worked on. Also discussed were the differences between the flexible conformity of asphalt and solid compaction of concrete.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of the personnel report regarding the resignation of Tucker Rasplicka, Equipment Operator, full-time Secondary Road Department as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports were held. Wood attended a Pathfinders meeting. Weber attended a Decat meeting. Hadley had no scheduled meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Bates informed the Remote Access agreement is being worked on and the county's mental health office furniture was removed from the Community Outreach Center last Friday.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:30 a.m.
