The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, August 18 2025, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Weber moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. Casey Jarmes, News Review was present.

Wood moved, Weber seconded to approve the minutes of August 11, 2025 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding Keokuk County Highway department was held. Keokuk County was successful as being selected for the Living Roadway Trust Fund grant in the amount of \$15,000 to be used towards the purchase of an excavator forestry head. Pricing is being requested from Altofer – Caterpillar, noting good service is critical. The asphalt project to Hayesville City limits is anticipated to take place the week following Labor Day.
