

BOARD MINUTES
AUGUST 25, 2025

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, August 25, 2025, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agenda as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Casey Jarmes, News Review was present.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the minutes of August 18, 2025 as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m.- Met with Andy McGuire, Engineer, regarding Keokuk County Highway department was held. Equipment operator applications are due tomorrow, August 26, 2025. Engineer ISAC meeting discussions included issues with Iowa County Engineer vacancies, the possibility of county sharing arrangements and Department of Transportation (DOT) coverage concerns thereof. Also discussed were matters related to the All-Systems Permit regarding who it applies to, enforcement thereof and concerns that Engineers are not equipped to analyze bridges.

1. Review and possible approval regarding Living Roadway Trust Fund (LRTF) Grant application for excavator mulcher was held. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the LRTF grant application as submitted and to authorize Engineer McGuire to sign on behalf of Keokuk County as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. 9:25 a.m. – Review and possible approval of participant form for Keokuk County to participate in the Sandoz Settlement agreement dated August 31, 2023. Sandoz is another opioid settlement agreement. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agreement as submitted and to authorize the Board of Supervisors Chairman to sign on behalf of Keokuk County as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:30 a.m. – Possible approval of personnel report for Jordan Redlinger, Jailer/Dispatcher, Sheriff’s Department, regarding classification change from full-time to part-time status was held. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the personnel report as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:35 a.m. - Various Board and Committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended a KCED Boost Grant meeting. Mike Hadley attended Semco, ISAC and DOT Freight meetings. Kevin Weber attended no meetings last week.

9:40 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. ISAC meeting discussions included review of procurement policy and dissolution of ISAC Work Comp group including twenty-one counties.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:45 a.m.
