

**BOARD MINUTES
OCTOBER 13, 2025**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, October 13, 2025, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agenda as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the minutes of October 6, 2025 as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m.- Andy McGuire, Engineer, was absent although he communicated with Deke Wood to address the following matters regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department: he would like to use the Rural Basic funds in the Board of Supervisors budget for crack-sealing in various areas, that includes the road to Belva Deer. He has spoken with a Denco representative and they could be here next week, as well as provide better pricing since they are in the area. Board consensus was approval to proceed with said project. Deke also shared several complaints that have been received regarding the road regrade south of Gibson, further noting the intersection has been improved to maneuver large equipment.

8:55 a.m. – Review and approval of quarterly report of fees collected by the County Auditor and Sheriff and monthly report of fees collected by the county Recorder and Clerk of Court was held. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the interfund transfer as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:00 a.m. - Various Board and Committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended a RUSS meeting. Kevin Weber attended a Decat meeting. Mike Hadley had no scheduled meetings last week.

9:05 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Christy Bates reminded of the early closing this Friday, October 17, 2025 for testing of the new generator. Deke Wood suggested contacting Ace Electric to inquire of interest in maintaining the new generator. Atwood Electric provided a quote to hard wire the desk setup in the Clerk of Court’s Office that was forwarded to Heidi Baker, District Court Administrator, for approval of payment thereof. The final equalization order notice was received from the Iowa Department of Revenue indicating no adjustments to the 2025 property in Keokuk County.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:15 a.m.
