

**BOARD MINUTES
NOVEMBER 10, 2025**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, November 10, 2025, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agenda as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarnes, News-Review.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the minutes of November 3, 2025 as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:40 a.m.- Review and possible approval of Eastern Iowa Workforce Development Area (EIWDA) Chief Elected Officials Shared Liability Agreement to fulfill responsibilities for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Services (WIOA) was held. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agreement as submitted, appoint himself, Kevin Weber, as the designated Keokuk County EIWDA member, time to correlate with his elected Supervisor term, and to authorize the Board of Supervisors Chairman to sign on behalf of Keokuk County. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m. – Review and possible approval of Sigourney Hometown Holiday Event application for use of the Keokuk County Courtyard on December 13th was held. Holly Ellis, KCED, informed this is a new committee that is taking over the Christmas activities and decorating of the courtyard. KCED will provide liability insurance. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the application as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:50 a.m. - Various Board and Committee reports were held. Deke Wood participated in a Pathfinders meeting by phone. Neither Kevin Weber nor Mike Hadley had scheduled meetings last week.

8:55 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Christy Bates reminded the November 4th City/School election first tier canvass will be held on Wednesday, November 12th at 9:00 a.m. and the second tier will be held on Tuesday, November 18th at 9:00 a.m. Discussion regarding the V45 culvert replacement project indicated it is nearing completion with minimal days left in the contract, patches are formed up and ready to pour.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:00 a.m.
