

**KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS**  
**NOVEMBER 24, 2025**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, November 24, 2025, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Weber moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Wood moved, Weber seconded to approve the minutes of November 17 & 18, 2025 as submitted. Weber seconded the November 17<sup>th</sup> minutes, Hadley seconded the November 18<sup>th</sup> minutes. All ayes and motion carried.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of resolution to assign county held tax sale certificate 2011165 (Marshall's Addition S 15' Lot 1 Block 10 & E ½ 12" N-S Alley W Lot 2 Block 10 in the City of Ollie, Keokuk County, Iowa) to Donnell and Tammy Haile as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department as follows: wings are being placed on the motor graders in preparation for snow; 123<sup>rd</sup> Street bridge update between North & South English: cement poured last Friday and upcoming Wednesday to lock in diaphragms. Hadley noted he received an Iowa County Engineers Association - Efficiency in Action flyer that notes the partnerships and sharing of Engineers, staff, equipment and projects between counties. Wood inquired about the soil stabilization project near Keota. McGuire stated this will be the third winter said area continues to be monitored and data collected for moisture content, with the underlying question being whether the cost is worth the benefit.

Wood moved, Weber seconded approval of certification of expenses for the November 4, 2025 Regular City-School Election as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of resolution regarding Keokuk County Policy for public records exemption and disclosure of security related information as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. IT Director Hite explained said policy defines what is allowed regarding security related open records requests.

Various Board and Committee reports were held. Wood attended RUSS and 1015 Transit meetings. Weber attended a KCED meeting. Hadley attended a Semco meeting last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Cunningham's called to inform they will be here this week for general HVAC maintenance.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:35.m.
