

BOARD MINUTES
NOVEMBER 24, 2025

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, November 24, 2025, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agenda as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarnes, News-Review.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the minutes of November 17 & 18, 2025, as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the November 17th minutes, Mike Hadley seconded the November 18th minutes. All ayes and motion carried.

8:40 a.m.- Consideration of proposal and possible approval of resolution to assign county held tax sale certificate 2011165 (Marshall's Addition S 15' Lot 1 Block 10 & E ½ 12" N-S Alley W Lot 2 Block 10 in the City of Ollie, Keokuk County, Iowa) to Donnell and Tammy Haile as presented. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to assign said county held tax sale certificate to Haile's as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m. – Meeting with Andy McGuire, Engineer, regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department was held. Andy informed wings are being placed on the motor graders in preparation for snow. Bridge update on 123rd Street west of Hwy 149 between North & South English: cement poured last Friday and upcoming Wednesday to lock in diaphragms. Mike Hadley noted he received an Iowa County Engineers Association - Efficiency in Action flyer that notes the partnerships and sharing of Engineers, staff, equipment and projects between counties. Deke Wood inquired about the soil stabilization project near Keota. Andy stated this will be the third winter said area continues to be monitored and data collected for moisture content, with the underlying question being whether the cost is worth the benefit.

9:10 a.m. – Certification of expenses for the November 4, 2025 Regular City-School Election and possible approval thereof was held. Robyn Smeltzer, Elections Designee, provided the breakdown regarding cost information for review. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the election expenses as submitted and to authorize the Board of Supervisors Chairman to sign on behalf of Keokuk County. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:15 a.m. – Consideration and possible approval of resolution regarding Keokuk County Policy for public records exemption and disclosure of security related information was held with Darin Hite, IT Director. Darin explained said policy defines what is allowed regarding security related open records requests. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the resolution as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:25 a.m. - Various Board and Committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended RUSS and 1015 Transit meetings. Kevin Weber attended a KCED meeting. Mike Hadley attended a Semco meeting last week.

9:30 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Cunningham's called to inform they will be here this week for general HVAC maintenance.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:35 a.m.
