The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, December 15, 2025, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor. was absent.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agenda as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarnes, News-Review; Darin Hite, IT; Christine Long, Treasurer and Pie Reighard, Conservation.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the minutes of December 8, 2025 as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. Mike Hadley abstained due to being absent from said meeting. All ayes and motion carried.

9:15 a.m. – Consideration and possible approval of the CEO Shared Liability Agreement of the New Eastern Iowa Workforce Development Board was held. Kevin Weber sits on said board and informed of the verbiage additions, N. Withdrawal and P. Amendments, to the agreement as the reason for revision. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agreement as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:20 a.m. - Various Board and Committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended Pathfinders, RUSS and 5th District meetings. Kevin Weber attended the 5th District meeting. Mike Hadley attended Emergency Management and 5th District meetings last week.

9:25 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Christy Bates informed payment was received for half of Keokuk County's balance from the ISAC Unemployment Pool in the amount of \$39,383.33 with the remaining balance to be paid once all current claims have been paid. Darin Hite and Christy Bates informed of an enhanced Keokuk County website development plan, initial set up fee and annual fee thereafter. Board consensus was to allow further investigation of said project. Inquiries arose regarding additional closure for the Christmas holiday, noting support would not be available from Tyler Technology, Department of Management and Department of Transportation due to closure from December 24-26, 2025. Christine Long stated her plan for the Treasurer's Office is ½ day on Christmas Eve and all day on the 26th, with employees taking leave for the additional time. This matter will be discussed during the upcoming department head meeting to gage what plans are for each department.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Deke Wood. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:40 a.m.
