

**BOARD MINUTES
DECEMBER 22, 2025**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, December 22, 2025, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agenda as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarnes, News-Review.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the minutes of December 15, 2025, as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m. – Discussion and possible approval of personnel reports for updated spraying licenses was held with Casey Clarahan, Engineers Assistant, regarding Keokuk County Highway Department employees Tyler Bramschreiber and Mark Sulentich.
