

**KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
DECEMBER 29, 2025**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, December 29, 2025, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Weber moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Wood moved, Weber seconded to approve the minutes of December 22, 2025, as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of resolution designating the News-Review as the official newspaper for Keokuk County for calendar year 2026 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Weber seconded approval of resolution re-appointing Dr. Jessica Webb as Keokuk County Medical Examiner; Jerlyn Bowers, Bonnie L. Clubb, Eric Coble, Mike Sellers as Keokuk County Medical Investigators; Mark & Andrea Hagist as Reserve Medical Investigators and new MEI appointment of Ashley Runnells as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Weber seconded approval for the Board of Supervisor Chair and Vice-Chair to remain unchanged and continue to serve on various boards and committees for calendar year 2026 as currently assigned. All ayes and motion carried.

Weber moved, Wood seconded acknowledgement of personnel report for Tami Gilliland regarding termination due to State elimination of position as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. Tami served as the Regional Mental Health Representative for Keokuk County until the end of November 2025.

Various Board and Committee reports were not held due to no scheduled meetings last week attributable to the Christmas holiday.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Assessor/GIS Sanders was present to inquire about setting a date for the Conference Board to meet toward the end of February. Bates distributed the 2025 taxable valuation report for FY2026/2027 tax levies; draft version of FY2026/2027 maximum budgetary levy rates allowed for General Basic and Rural Basic; Iowa Code sections on Compensation Board requirements and the ISAC salary survey comparison report for review, with plans to meet with department heads during the January 5th Board of Supervisors meeting.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:15 a.m.
