

**KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS  
JANUARY 19, 2026**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, January 19, 2026 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor. Michael C. Hadley was absent.

Wood moved, Weber seconded to approve the agenda as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Weber moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of January 12, 2026, as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. Crews are cutting brush east on Hwy 149 and west and south of South English. No trucks were out on Saturday, cleared pavements on Sunday and again this morning to clean drifts off across the pavements. Andy spoke of the Transportation Research Board meeting he attended in Washington D.C. last week. National Academy of Resource individuals presented on all topics related to transportation. The Engineer's Executive Board discussed how counties were interpreting the big beautiful bill regarding overtime reporting.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of updated personnel reports for David Brooks and James Olinger regarding spraying license endorsement and receipt of a 25 ¢ per hour salary increase for said endorsement. Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of resolution providing financial support of the Regional Planning Affiliation (RPA 15) in the amount of \$3,697 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of resolution of financial commitment for the AHEAD Regional Housing Trust Fund (RHTF) in the amount of \$2,007 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports were held. Wood attended HIPAA and RUSS meetings. Weber had scheduled meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Sanders, Assessor/GIS, was present to discuss February 19, 2026 as the Conference Board meeting date, with February 26<sup>th</sup> as a backup plan in case of inclement weather and also distributed the Assessor's affiliation summary on the Senate and Governor proposals.

On vote and motion Wood adjourned the meeting at 9:35 a.m.
