

**BOARD MINUTES
JANUARY 19, 2026**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, January 19, 2026 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor. Michael C. Hadley was absent.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agenda as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the minutes of January 12, 2026, as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m. – Met with Andy McGuire, Engineer, regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. Crews are cutting brush east on Hwy 149 and also west and south of South English. No trucks were out on Saturday, cleared pavements on Sunday and again this morning to clean drifts off across the pavements. Andy spoke of the Transportation Research Board meeting he attended in Washington D.C. last week. National Academy of Resource individuals presented on all topics related to transportation. The Engineer’s Executive Board discussed how counties were interpreting the big beautiful bill regarding overtime reporting.

Drew also distributed the Assessor's affiliation summary on the Senate and Governor proposals.
