The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors held their special scheduled meeting on Monday, March 23, 2026, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber, and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Weber moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Public hearing regarding Proposed Property Tax levy for FY2027 was held. No oral or written objections were received. No members of the public were present. Wood moved, Weber seconded to close the public hearing at 9:05 a.m.

Hadley motioned to adjourn. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:06 a.m.

McGuire informed of the following: filled out a survey regarding rock salt for next year in the amount of 200 ton; is hopeful for a price break in leftover paint from last year for pavement line striping; working on developing box culvert and bridge plans for upcoming projects; Calhoun & Burns are currently performing bridge inspections and continue to wait on whether Keokuk County will be a Competitive Highway Bridge Program (CHBP) grant award recipient.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of certification of expenses in the amount of \$2,024.61 for the March 3, 2026, Special Keota School Election as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports were held. Wood attended Farm Bureau and Assessor Conference Board meetings. Weber attended a Farm Bureau meeting. Hadley attended a Semco meeting last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. The FY27 Keokuk County proposed budget will be published in the March 25, 2026 News-Review.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:55 a.m.
