

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
APRIL 13, 2026

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, April 13, 2026, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber, and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Weber moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried. Also present were Darrell Wilkening, What Cheer Mayor and Gary Joe Van Patten, Maintenance Man.

Wood moved, Weber seconded to approve the minutes of April 6, 2026, as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of Personnel Report for resignation of Joshua Myers, Full Time Jailer/Dispatcher, Sheriff's Department as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports were held. Wood attended RUSS and Endowment meetings. Hadley attended the Endowment meeting. Weber had no scheduled meetings last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Casey Clarahan, Assistant to the Engineer, Darrell Wilkening and Gary Joe Van Patten, What Cheer representatives were present to inquire about the possibility of contracting with Keokuk County Secondary Roads regarding summer blading maintenance of Section Street (approximately 1 mile) and Briney Street (approximately 4-6 blocks), of which are heavily farm traffic roads, due to the breakdown of the city maintainer. Board consensus was they are not opposed to the idea, but it would have to work for the roads department. Casey mentioned they will work on a cost estimate to present.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:00 a.m.
