

BOARD MINUTES
APRIL 13, 2026

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, April 13, 2026, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber, and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agenda. Daryl Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present were Darrell Wilkening, What Cheer Mayor and Gary Joe Van Patten, Maintenance Man.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Daryl Wood to approve the minutes of April 6, 2026, as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:40 a.m. -Possible approval of Personnel Report for resignation of Joshua Myers, Full Time Jailer/Dispatcher, Sheriff's Department was held. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve said Personnel Report with resignation date of April 2, 2026, as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m. - Various Board and Committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended RUSS and Endowment meetings. Mike Hadley attended the Endowment meeting. Kevin Weber had no scheduled meetings last week.

8:50 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Casey Clarahan, Assistant to the Engineer, Darrell Wilkening and Gary Joe Van Patten, What Cheer representatives were present to inquire about the possibility of contracting with Keokuk County Secondary Roads regarding summer blading maintenance of Section Street (approximately 1 mile) and Briney Street (approximately 4-6 blocks), of which are heavily farm traffic roads, due to the breakdown of the city maintainer. Board consensus was they are not opposed to the idea, but it would have to work for the roads department. Noted discussion included establishment of a rate to be charged, possible 28E agreement and price comparison of a private source versus county. Casey mentioned that Engineer McGuire is out all week, but he will bring this matter to his attention once he returns and get a cost estimate back to the Supervisors for review and What Cheer Mayor to take to City Council.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:00 a.m.
