

BOARD MINUTES
APRIL 27, 2026

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, April 27, 2026, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber, and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agenda. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Kirk Beasley.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the minutes of April 20, 2026, as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Terry Green and Willie Coffman stopped in to discuss rock and grass that was pushed into their ditch by the motorgrader, to the extent they can't mow. The Board directed them to file a complaint with the Secondary Roads department.

8:45 a.m. – Met with Andy McGuire, Engineer, regarding Keokuk County Highway Department was held. Andy discussed the settlement issue regarding the spot on the Keswick Road stating it passed the standard compaction tests during construction. He is talking with DeLong Construction regarding working together on a solution. Andy informed of a petition received from four landowners regarding a road vacation located on old Hwy 77 to be aware of. Kevin Weber inquired about employee concerns regarding the debris that is spilling over on the Hedrick maintenance shop property. Andy replied there is employee frustration regarding said matter, it is not ideal, but they can still get in and out of said location. The Board congratulated Andy on his re-election as South-Central Region Vice President of the National Association of County Engineers (NACE) that will run through April of 2028. Andy replied it is an honor and privilege to serve the nation's county road professionals for a second term.

1. Discussion and possible approval of IDOT Keokuk County 5-year Construction Program was held. Andy reviewed the projects in said plan that included bridge replacements, rehabs, deck overlays and road overlays, specifically noting the fiscal year 2027 projects and possible grant funding thereof. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the Keokuk County 5-year Construction Program as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:20 a.m. – Approval of interfund operating transfer resolution from Local Option Sales Tax (LOST) Fund to Debt Service Fund in the sum totaling \$193,270 was held. These funds are regarding repayment of the General Obligation Bond used for road and bridge projects. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the transfer as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:25 a.m. – Review and approval of Anderson Larkin & Co engagement letter for the year ending June 30, 2026 was held. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the engagement letter as submitted and to authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to sign on behalf of Keokuk County. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:30 a.m. - Various Board and Committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended a 1015 Transit meeting. Kevin Weber attended a Keokuk County Economic Development (KCED) meeting. Mike Hadley attended a Sieda meeting last week.

9:35 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. It was reported this morning that rainwater was leaking in the Courtroom ceiling and around the corner of east window in the IT room. A few pieces of tile had blown off the Courthouse roof a short while ago that are to be replaced once the ordered materials arrive.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:40 a.m.

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors adjourned to meet Monday, May 4, 2026.
