

**KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
JUNE 1, 2026**

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, June 1, 2026, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor. Daryl Wood was absent.

Weber moved, Hadley seconded to approve the agenda as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Weber moved, Wood read, approved and signed May 26th minutes on May 27, 2026 due to being absent for today's meeting as submitted. Mike Hadley abstained due to being absent from said meeting, motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department as follows: informed of plans to apply for Competitive Highway Bridge Program (CHBP) funding; spoke of using dynamic infrastructure for bridge deficiencies by placing Calhoun-Burns data into closed AI that looks through the history of the bridge and evaluates the critical state. The bridge on 200th Street, north of Keota, will be replaced using a recycling tank car. Nathan Wood called in to share concern that the dip on Keswick Road continues to settle and is dangerous.

Public hearing regarding vacating county roadway 328th Avenue, Section 14, Township 74N, Range 10W Richland Township was held. Present were Jerry Hartnell and Dave Pfeifer, adjacent landowners of said roadway. No oral or written objections were received. Engineer McGuire reviewed the public hearing process and landowner requests of gates to be provided by the county and to fix the drainage issue from east to west. The county does not supply gates or road maintenance prior to road closures. It was noted that Jerry Hartnell must sign the order to take ownership of the bridge prior to action on the final order or road closure. Hadley moved, Weber seconded to close the public hearing at 9:14 a.m.

Formal action will take place regarding the final order on road vacation in Section 14, Township 74N, Range 10W Richland Township 328th Avenue following the upcoming second public hearing on said matter.

Weber moved, Hadley seconded approval of June 1, 2026 claims listing as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.
