

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
JUNE 22, 2026

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, June 22, 2026, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Weber moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Weber seconded to approve the minutes of June 15, 2026 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department as follows: the Pigeon Road project is moving forward due to the HSID grant funding award with the help of Mariannette Miller-Meeks; the Lancaster road pavement is crumbling near Ollie city limits noting replacement of a box culvert needs done prior to paving, questioning funding participation by the City of Ollie; new speed limit law on two-lane roadways from 55 to 60 mph officially takes effect on July 1, 2026 with no specific guidance on how to implement the changeover of related key factors; data research continues on the Keota area soil test plots; the benefit of crack sealing was discussed; Trent and Tessa Steinhart are requesting a road vacation that will be placed on the agenda for discussion and Dynamic Infrastructure will present next week regarding AI for bridge inspections used from physical data collected by Calhoun/Burns.

Public hearing for a road vacation, including the sale and conveyance of Keokuk County Bridge 401498 to Jerry Hartnell, on 328th Avenue between 310th Street and 305th Street in Section 14, Township 74N, Range 10W, Richland Township was held. Also present was Jerry Hartnell. No oral, written or public comments were received. Wood moved, Weber seconded to close the public hearing at 9:04 a.m. Motion carried.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of final order on road vacation, including the sale and conveyance of Keokuk County Bridge 401498 to Jerry Hartnell, on 328th Avenue between 310th Street and 305th Street in Section 14, Township 74N, Range 10W, Richland Township as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. Jerry Hartnell made payment of \$1.00 for purchase of bridge 401498.

Wood moved, Weber seconded approval of resolution of abandonment and quit claim of road vacation, including the sale and conveyance of Keokuk County Bridge 401498 to Jerry Hartnell, on 328th Avenue between 310th Street and 305th Street in Section 14, Township 74N, Range 10W, Richland Township as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Weber seconded re-appointment of Richard Bond to the Keokuk County Veteran's Affairs Commission for a three-year term starting July 1, 2026 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of interfund operating transfer from Rural Basic Fund (\$467,500) and Local Option Sales Tax (LOST) Fund (\$50,000) to Secondary Road Fund as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports were held. Weber attended Early Childhood, Keokuk County Economic Development (KCED) and Decat meetings. Hadley attended a Semco meeting. Wood had scheduled meetings to attend last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Tuckpointing, clock tower and roof restoration was the topic of discussion and funding thereof.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 10:00 a.m.
