The update included employees Kaden Foubert, new Deputy Sheriff, full-time and Brycen William Dolan, Deputy Sheriff, classification change from full-time to part-time. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the updated resolution as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:55 a.m.- Various Board and Committee reports were held. None of the Supervisors had scheduled meetings to attend last week.

9:00 a.m.-Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Taylor Zehr and Cody Davis, Keokuk County Ambulance employees, provided a drafted EMS resolution for review. Board consensus was they have inquiries regarding said draft to be discussed that included establishment of Advisory Council members, if members have already been established as stated in the resolution, and what entities will receive funding from said EMS levy if passed. Tuckpointing the clock tower and roof restoration proposals will be placed on next week’s agenda as an action item.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:20 a.m.
