

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
JULY 13, 2026

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, July 13, 2026, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Weber moved, Wood seconded to approve the agenda as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Weber seconded to approve the minutes of July 6 & 9, 2026 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department was held.

The letter of support for Competitive Highway Bridge Program (CHBP) grant application regarding the following two bridges located west of the Ollie quarry on Hwy 67 and V5G and the other on the gravel road between west of Hwy 21 and Fremont will be included in said application.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of 28E Agreement for Competitive Highway Bridge Program (CHBP) grant application as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Weber seconded to approve Dynamic Infrastructure Bridge Maintenance Services one-year contract if negotiated for \$15,000 or less. All ayes and motion carried.

Public hearing for a road vacation on 188th Avenue North of 240th Street between Sections 9/16, Township 75N, Range 12W, Sigourney Township was held. No written or oral objections were received. Wood moved, Weber seconded to close the public hearing at 9:04 a.m.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of final order and resolution of abandonment and quit claim of road vacation on 188th Avenue North of 240th Street between Sections 9/16, Township 75N, Range 12W, Sigourney Township as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Weber seconded acknowledgement of personnel report for Justin Devine, Assistant Field Appraiser, Assessor's Office, as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. Drew Sanders, Assessor/GIS informed his start date is July 20, 2026.

Weber moved, Wood seconded approval of personnel report regarding resignation of Adam Clark, full-time deputy, Sheriff's Department as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Weber seconded approval of personnel report for Jordan Redlinger, Jailer/Dispatcher, Sheriff's Department, regarding classification change from part-time to full-time as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports were held. All three of the Supervisors attended the BOOST meeting last week. Wood also attended annual and monthly RUSS meetings.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Discussion regarding a Data Center ordinance once again took place noting the negative aspects being water and electrical usage and possible increase in utility costs. TnT Tuckpointing will be contacted to set a date to meet and clarify their proposal regarding the roof renovation project.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:20 a.m.
