

BOARD MINUTES
JULY 21, 2026

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in special session, Tuesday, July 21, 2026, in the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Kevin Weber, and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

9:30 a.m. – Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agenda as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:31 a.m. – Meeting with Mike Lee, TnT Tuckpointing & Building Restoration, LLC, regarding review of clock tower restoration project proposal was held. Mike summarized the restoration and repair of locations stated in the proposal as follows: the exterior will be pressure washed with limestone restorer; patch deteriorated natural stone; sounding, removal and replacement of deteriorated stucco in interior of clock tower; removal and replacement of bricks; and to tuckpoint and seal all mortar joints. Contract alternatives included for considerations are: #1 – Metal dome cleaning and painting, and #2 – Masonry water repellent. This project is anticipated to last 2-2½ months, accommodations include use of 3-5 parking spaces and location for FMC3 set up,

Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:45 a.m.
