

BOARD MINUTES
AUGUST 24, 2026

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, August 24, 2026, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were Michael C. Hadley, Kevin Weber, Daryl Wood, and LuAnn Berger, recording secretary. Absent was Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Kevin Weber to approve the agenda. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Michael Hadley to approve the minutes of August 18, 2026, as submitted. Kevin Weber seconded the motion. Deke Wood abstained due to not being at said meeting. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m. -Meeting with Andy McGuire, Engineer, regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department was held. Andy informed the Board of Meadowbrook issues concerning roads, people parking in right-of-way, road rock washing, and a culvert in poor shape. The county will need to do something regarding the storm water drainage, but no decision was made at this time.

1. Consideration of 6 county sharing agreement for the acquisition of a road reclaimer for granular road stabilization was held. Andy McGuire stated each county is bringing this proposal before their Board of Supervisors to see if there is any interest in a sharing agreement before proceeding. This would be for a used Weiler S200 stabilizer which allows chemicals to be injected into the soil. The reclaimer would be used when gravel roads are being rebuilt, therefore getting more life out of our gravel roads. Purchase price is \$193,750.00 divided by 6 equals \$32,291.66 per county. This does not include Keokuk County in the shared costs, so potentially it could be a little less. Scheduling would be done by a rolling calendar ahead of time, so that each county would know when it is available. Board consensus was to proceed with discussions for said sharing agreement.

9:50 a.m. - Various Board and Committee reports were held. Mike Hadley attended ISAC meetings in Des Moines. Kevin Weber attended ECI and KCED meetings. At the KCED meeting a REC representative was there and mentioned they do a roundup and donate proceeds to different organizations. Kevin mentioned the Courthouse clock tower project. The representative will take the idea back to the company.

9:52 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was not held due to no old/new business or public comment.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 10:00 a.m.

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors adjourned to meet Monday, August 31, 2026.
