

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
FEBRUARY 8, 2021

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, February 8, 2021 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of February 1, 2021 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. Crews worked on snow removal Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday and came in early Monday morning.

Public hearing regarding status of funding for the Keokuk County Emergency Public Health Program Project was held. No oral or written objections were received. Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to close said public hearing. All ayes and the public hearing closed at 9:07 a.m.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve CDBG funding assistance in the amount of \$18,478 to address public health safety pertaining to the coronavirus pandemic as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to set proposed maximum property tax levy public hearing for Monday, February 22, 2021 at 9:30 a.m., Board Room, First Floor, Courthouse. All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended a Pathfinders meeting and informed Mick Berg was formally approved as a citizen member. Snakenberg participated in an Iowa Workforce Development meeting by phone. Hadley attended an Iowa County Engineer Service Agency in Des Moines last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Tweaking of the Keokuk County FY22 budget and summarized legislative session bills regarding (SF 77), a bill abolishing the county compensation board and (SF 108), a bill requiring the compensation board to factor in economic situations and provide documentation to the board of supervisors to demonstrate how they reached the recommended compensation schedule. The Courthouse is closed Monday, February 15th for President's Day.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 10:18 a.m.
