8:55 a.m.-Possible approval of SEIL letter of support regarding Optimae partnership was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve said letter of support as submitted and to authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to sign on behalf of Keokuk County. Mike Hadley seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:00 a.m.-Ratification of South Central Iowa Workforce Area Chief Elected Official Shared Liability Agreement was held. Fred Snakenberg signed said agreement on March 12, 2021 as per requested by Krista Tedrow, Executive Director of SCIW Development Board. Motion was made by Mike Hadley to ratify said action. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:00 a.m.-Various board and committee reports were held. Fred Snakenberg participated in a SEIL-Regional Mental Health meeting. Mike Hadley attended the Emergency Management Commission meeting last week.

9:05 a.m.-Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Christy Bates stated there have been numerous public inquiries regarding action taken in the open session of the Emergency Management meeting, when minutes would be available to view and noted no claim was submitted for payment of the special investigation. Mike Hadley replied there were 14 of the 18 entities represented at the March 10th Emergency Management meeting. A vote was held following discussion as whether to allow or disallow continued employment of Larry Smith as Emergency Management Coordinator due to findings of the recent audit performed by the Auditor of State's Office. The results of the vote were: 9 members voted to retain and 5 members voted to disallow retainage of said position. Majority ruled to retain employment, although Larry Smith was subjected to a week of suspension from work without pay. The minutes will not be available until approved by the EM Commission at the next meeting and the Commission accepted responsibility for the claim. The Kiwanis is interested in visiting with the Board regarding a courtyard project. The Board of Supervisors meeting for March 22nd will begin at 9:30 a.m. instead of 8:30 a.m. due to the Judicial project walk-through.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:45 a.m.

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors adjourned to meet March 22, 2021.
