9:25 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Christy reminded of the HF718 mandated March 20, 2024 mailing regarding proposed FY25 property taxes that includes the county, cities and schools information. Richard Jones, What Cheer resident, entered to discuss city issues. The Board of Supervisors informed they have no jurisdiction over city matters and suggested legal assistance. Christine Edmundson Long, Treasurer, was present to discuss employee replacement. Board consensus denied replacement due to budget constraints caused by HF718 and fear worse conditions in the future. Zack, Cunningham representative, entered to give an update on the HVAC compressor replacement and response to the life expectancy inquiry as 20-25 years.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:45 a.m.
