

BOARD MINUTES
APRIL 1, 2024

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, April 1, 2024, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Fred Snakenberg and Christy Bates, Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agenda. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarnes, News-Review.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of previous board meeting minutes was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve both special and regular sets of minutes for March 25, 2024 as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m. – Meeting with Engineer Andy McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway department was not held due to absence.

9:00 a.m. – Review and possible approval of second amendment to tower and ground space lease with USCOC of Greater Iowa, LLC regarding the lease of the 911 tower space was held. Aaron Kephart, 911 Coordinator, was present to inform he contacted Duane Vos, Racom, to inquire if there are concerns the county needs to consider if additional equipment is allowed on the tower. Duane’s response was there are no loading or frequency concerns due to US Cellular equipment operating on its own, therefore having no adverse effect on the county. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the second amendment to the US Cellular tower lease as submitted and to authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to sign on behalf of Keokuk County.
