

BOARD MINUTES
APRIL 3, 2023

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, April 3, 2023 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agenda. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:35 a.m. - Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the minutes of March 27, 2023 as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m. - Met with Engineer Andy McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. Terry Greene was present to discuss shared dust control due to hauling out of the Harper rock quarry. Andy stated the county is not hauling out of that quarry, it is not active, therefore use is a hit and miss for hauling of leftover rock. Andy informed they were busy closing roads and setting signs on Friday following the storm and Saturday as well. Today starts removal of debris from the ditches.

1. Review and possible approval of Keokuk County Secondary Roads FY24 budget and five-year construction program to be submitted to the Iowa DOT was held. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the budget and program as submitted. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:50 a.m. - Review and approval of claims listing dated April 3, 2023 was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the claims listing as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:55 a.m. – Consideration and possible approval of the Topsy Traveler’s Class C - 5-day retail alcohol license application was held. All documents were in order. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the application as submitted and to authorize the Board of Supervisor Chairman to sign on behalf of Keokuk County. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

10:00 a.m. – Approval of American Rescue Plan Act resolution and allocation of state and local fiscal recovery funds to spend on government services was held. Motion was made by Mike Hadley to approve the ARPA resolution as submitted. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

10:10 a.m. – Various Board and Committee reports was held. Mike Hadley attended Sieda and Area 15 meetings. Neither Deke Wood nor Fred Snakenberg had scheduled meetings last week.

10:15 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Concern was shared regarding county impact if SF 550 would pass that is being considered by the legislature to eliminate the Local Option Sales Tax and make it a statewide sales tax. Casey Hinnah, Sheriff, was present to discuss storm happenings and help provided by neighboring Emergency Management Coordinators, as well as procedure timeline regarding hire of new emergency management individual.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
