

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
APRIL 19, 2021

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, April 19, 2021 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda with the addition to ratify inclusion of setting public hearing date and time oversight of April 12, 2021 regarding proposal to donate and transfer Keokuk County tax sale certificate to the City of Delta. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to ratify proposal to donate and transfer Keokuk County tax sale certificate to the City of Delta action to include setting the public hearing as May 3, 2021 at 8:31 a.m., in the Boardroom, first floor of the Courthouse, in Sigourney, Iowa, as stated in the resolution. All ayes and motion carried. Publication of the public hearing will be in the News-Review.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of April 12, 2021 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department happenings as follows: rocked and reshaped the recycling center driveway; transitioning equipment; ditching; motor graders are on all routes; rocking and working on culvert projects, inventory and discussed possibility of using a railroad tank car.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the claim listing dated April 19, 2021 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the reports of fees collected by the Auditor & Sheriff (quarterly) and Recorder & Clerk of Court (monthly) as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval to set Keokuk County FY21 budget amendment public hearing for May 10, 2021 at 8:31 a.m., Board Room, First Floor, Courthouse, Sigourney, IA. All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended a RUSS meeting. Snakenberg participated in a zoom SEIL meeting. Hadley attended an Emergency Management meeting last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Bates shared information provided by the US Treasury regarding guidance on the American Rescue Plan Act certification process for state and local fiscal recovery funds. Wood discussed the projected bandstand/courtyard project.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:50 a.m.
