

BOARD MINUTES
APRIL 26, 2021

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, April 26, 2021 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Nikki Talbert, Auditor's Designee. Christy Bates, County Auditor, was absent.

8:30 a.m.-Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agenda. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was R.D. Keep, News-Review.

8:35 a.m.-Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the minutes of April 19, 2021 as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m.-Meeting with Andy McGuire, Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department was not held due to Andy being out of the office.

9:00 a.m.-Review and possible approval of listing of Keokuk County residents that qualify for tax suspension pursuant to Section 427.9 of the Code of Iowa was held. The Iowa Department of Human Services confirmed eligibility of the individuals listed as submitted by the Keokuk County Treasurer's Office. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve said listing as submitted. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. These taxes are suspended, not forgiven, and will be due upon sale or change of ownership.

9:05 a.m.-Various board and committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended HIPAA and 1015 Transit meetings. Fred Snakenberg attended a SADC meeting. Mike Hadley attended Endowment and Semco meetings last week.

9:10 a.m.-Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. The road (190th Avenue) north of Keswick from city limits to 120th Street will be closed on May 3, 2021 for bridge replacement with anticipated construction to take 4 to 5 months.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:20 a.m.
