The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, May 19, 2021 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg and Christy Bates, County Auditor. Daryl Wood was absent.

Hadley moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried. RD Keep, News-Review was present.

Snakenberg moved, Hadley seconded to approve the minutes of May 10, 2021 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the claim listing dated May 17, 2021 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Snakenberg moved, Hadley seconded approval of application from SADC for use of the Keokuk County Courthouse grounds on Wednesday evenings from 4 to 7 p.m. for the months of June through October 2021 to hold a weekly farmers market pending receipt of certificate of liability insurance. All ayes and motion carried.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Hadley stated the Semco building of new cell bids were received and will share information next week.
