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8:45 a.m. – Discussion and possible update regarding Iowa Public Funds Investment Resolution was requested to be tabled by Christine Edmundson Long, Treasurer until next week.

8:50 a.m. -Discussion and possible update regarding Iowa Public Funds Investment (IPAIT) resolution was held with Christine Edmundson Long, Treasurer. Also present were Pie Reighard, Conservation Director and Amber Thompson, County Attorney. Information was distributed for review indicating IPAIT is a cash management program exclusively for Iowa’s public institutions. Pie had inquiries regarding the procedures and whether this is as safe as a bank due to sizeable Conservation fund balances, further noting these are public funds, not tax dollars. Christine responded IPAIT is safe, no changes will be seen, except for higher interest and REAP is the only interest-bearing conservation account. Pie questioned where the interest went for his other funds. Christine responded to the general fund. Mike Hadley commented that moving funds to IPAIT for better interest rates is just business and the local banks cannot match the percentage rate. Amber Thompson stated she does not have the document that is referred to in section 1 of the IPAIT resolution to review and therefore cannot make a recommendation to move forward with IPAIT. Motion was made by Deke Wood to table this matter until said document is reviewed. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:00 a.m. – Setting the time, date and place for the public hearing regarding Secondary Roads budget amendment fiscal year 2024 was held. The publication document regarding said amendment was reviewed. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve June 3, 2024 at 9:00 a.m.to be held in the Keokuk County Boardroom on 1st floor of the Courthouse as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:10 a.m. – Various Board and Committee reports were held. Mike Hadley attended Semco and Emergency Management meetings. Fred Snakenberg participated in Early Childhood meeting. Deke Wood had no scheduled meetings last week.

9:15 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Christy Bates informed of the phone conference with IGCHP regarding the tight timeframe to hold employee meetings and benefit enrollment on May 28, 2024.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:25 a.m.
