

KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS
JUNE 1, 2021

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Tuesday, June 1, 2021 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried.

Hadley moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the minutes of May 24, 2021 as submitted. Wood abstained due to absence. Motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of application for use of Keokuk County Courthouse grounds southwest quarter on July 3, 2021 by the Ministerial Alliance for Bluegrass Blondies starting at 6:00 p.m. All ayes and motion carried. It was noted the street dance is traditionally held the evening of July 3rd and located on the northeast quarter of square/courtyard.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded approval of application for use of Keokuk County Courthouse grounds southwest quarter on July 4, 2021 by the Sigourney Ministerial Alliance for the ecumenical worship starting at 7:00 a.m. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of FY22 salary certifications as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended RUSS (May 12th), 1015 Transit and RPA Policy Board meetings last week. Hadley attended Sieda, Board of Health and Ahead/Rural Housing Trust Fund meetings. Snakenberg completed and submitted paperwork for Decat as requested.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Jerry Wohler was present to discuss the upcoming July 4th holiday activities, use of courthouse grounds, mentioned scheduling the parade on Sunday, July 4th and informed an organizational meeting is being held at the Sigourney Golf & Country Clubhouse on June 8, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. County Treasurer Edmundson entered to remind the annual tax sale will be held on-line, instead of in-person, on June 21, 2021. County Auditor Bates informed she submitted the American Rescue Plan funding application.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 9:30 a.m.
