8:55 a.m.-Discussion and approval of moving the Veterans Affairs' office to the former County Attorney's office on the 3rd floor of the Keokuk County Courthouse was held. Present were: Keith Blair, VA Director and Michelle Herman, VA Director in training and Richard Bond and Floyd Strupp, VA Commissioners. Michelle informed VA would like to move from their current office to the third floor noting privacy purposes and additional room. Keith stated they were asking for formal board action to eliminate any possible confusion regarding approval of relocation. Richard commented he is definitely in favor of the move, commented it had been discussed but not pushed for the past couple of years and timing is right due to new director. Richard also informed VA Commissioner Jerry Whitehurst is also in favor of the move but was unable to be in attendance today. Floyd voiced privacy is extremely important. Board consensus was to approve the request providing Michelle felt comfortable with the move and new location thereof. Her response was in favor of the move. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve move. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. Keith stated the VA grant would fund any new office equipment/supplies.

9:05 a.m.-Various board and committee reports were held. Fred Snakenberg participated in a Decat meeting by zoom. Neither Deke Wood or Mike Hadley had meetings to attend last week.

9:10 a.m.-Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Pie Reighard, Conservation Director, entered to discuss the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding and possible ideas for use thereof. The Department of Revenue sent a letter certifying Drew Sanders, Keokuk County Assessor, completed the continuing education requirements as set forth by Code of Iowa and is eligible for reappointment.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 9:25 a.m.
