Andy informed the Service Bureau is struggling to get plan reviews done, need help with development, setup and close out of projects.

9:30 a.m. – Various Board and Committee reports were held. Fred Snakenberg participated in a Decat meeting. Mike Hadley and Deke Wood had no scheduled meetings last week.

9:35 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. County resident complaints were shared regarding unnecessary treatment by the recycling center employees. Mike Hadley will follow up on this matter. Deke Wood informed Team Mobile is acquiring US Cellular and inquired what effect this will have, if any, to our current contract.
