KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEDURES JUNE 19, 2023

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, June 19, 2023 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Fred Snakenberg and Christy Bates, County Auditor. was absent.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of June 12, 2023 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Met with Engineer McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department as follows: grinding on the Pekin pavement has been completed with only markings yet to do; crack sealing has been completed on the various roads and the salt shed construction has been completed. Bid letting for V5G concrete overlay from Hwy 149 to 280th Street takes place tomorrow, Tuesday – June 20th and additional contact continues with the IDOT regarding Keokuk County to tie in with said project for 1900' of county responsibility.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of claims listing dated June 19, 2023 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded approval of quarterly interfund operating transfer from Rural Services Fund of \$430,500 and LOST fund of \$130,750 to the Secondary Roads Funds as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of City of Sigourney use of Courthouse grounds application for July 4th Celebration (June 30 – July 4, 2023) as submitted. All ayes and motion carried

Met with Jathan Chicoine and Mike Cockrun to discuss the Home Base Iowa Program. The purpose of the program is to bridge the work force, higher education and community support gap with veterans. Also present was Veterans Affairs/Community Services Administrator Herman, Keith Blair and Jerry Whitehurst, Veterans Affairs Commissioners.

Meeting with Kiwanis representatives to discuss progress of pavilion project was tabled due to waiting on estimates.

Various board and committee reports were held. Wood attended RUSS and Crime Commission meetings. Snakenberg participated in SEIL regional mental health meetings. Hadley attended a Freight Council meeting last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Treasurer Edmundson Long shared there are 549 bidders for the 211 parcels involved in the tax sale. The Veterans Affairs Administrator and Commissioners inquired of moving to first floor and also placement of a 20' cube storage container at the old shop. The Veterans Memorial site around the flag on the northwest corner is currently being worked on. Board consensus was removal of the dying tree located on the east side due to the majority being full of dead branches.

On vote and motion Hadley adjourned the meeting at 10:15 a.m.
