

BOARD MINUTES
JULY 26, 2021

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, July 26, 2021 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.- Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agenda. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:35 a.m.- Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the minutes of July 19, 2021 as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:45 a.m.- Met with Andy McGuire, Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department happenings as follows: the 3-mile section of Lacey Road project that lies in Keokuk County is being paved and a larger crew has been brought in to work on the bridge north of Keswick to get it back on schedule.

1. Review and possible award of contract for Project PP-2022(1)-54 P.C.C. pavement patch in various locations in the county. Bids received were: Ten Point Construction - \$163,569.60; TEK Builder LLC - \$173,321.87; A&J Excavation LLC - \$196,803.20; Denco Highway Corp - \$216,829.89 and Cedar Falls Const. Co. Inc.- \$217,687.80. Andy informed he budgeted \$200,000 for patching and would like approval to bump up the patches to equal those dollars. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve award of contract to Ten Point Construction in the amount of \$163,569.60 (low bid) and to increase the number of patches to equal budgeted dollars thereof. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:20 a.m.- Possible approval of personnel report for hire of Allison J. Morgan, full-time dispatch/jailer, Sheriff's Department, was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the personnel report for Allison J. Morgan, dispatch/jailer full-time at \$16 per hour, effective July 26, 2021 as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

9:25 a.m.-Various board and committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended a 1015 Transit meeting and participated in a RUSS phone call. Fred Snakenberg participated in an Early Childhood Development meeting. Mike Hadley attended a Semco meeting last week.

9:45 a.m.-Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Mike Hadley informed he spoke with Dwight Schumm, Design Engineers PC, last week to discuss possible courthouse upgrades. Plans were made for a visit in the near future.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
