## KEOKUK COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS AUGUST 7, 2023

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, August 7, 2023, in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Daryl Wood, Fred Snakenberg and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to approve the agenda. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Casey Jarmes, News-Review.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded to approve the minutes of July 31, 2023, as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of August 7, 2023, claim listing as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded approval of proposal and resolution to assign county held tax sale certificate 201900309 to Michael Bloem for the following described parcel: 2/75/12 E ½ Railroad ROW thru Lots 6 & 7, & Lot 6 E of Railroad BLK 16 Plat 40/253, Sigourney as submitted. All ayes and motion carried. Also present was Amber Thompson, County Attorney, Michael Bloem and Christine Edmundson Long, Treasurer.

Board consensus was to hold off on consideration of Renodry USA project due to upcoming changes in building airflow dynamics with the new HVAC system.

Snakenberg moved, Wood seconded approval of FY24 local match resolution providing for \$2,652 in financial support of the Regional Planning Affiliation (RPA 15) as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Wood moved, Snakenberg seconded to accept the only bid received for air handler and outdoor condensing unit by David Goldman in the amount of \$200 as submitted. All ayes and motion carried.

Various Board and Committee reports was held. Wood participated in a phone conversation with Steve Roquet regarding his property and the pipeline controversy. Snakenberg attended a townhall meeting with Senator Joni Ernest. Hadley had no meeting to attend last week.

Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Paul Horak plans to schedule a time to meet with the Board of Supervisors to discuss the county's insurance policy. The annual financial report will be on next week's agenda for review and approval.
