Met with Gary Iosbaker and Holly Van Voltenburg, SADC representatives regarding Keokuk County Economic Development (KCED) update. Gary noted how HF718 legislative changes will financially affect the City of Sigourney in years to come and KCED 5 pillars of growth plan to grow economy in Keokuk County, one being childcare development.

Various Board and Committee reports was held. Wood attended a 1015 Transit meeting. Snakenberg participated in an Early Childhood Development meeting. Hadley attended SADC loan, Board of Health, Area 15, CO2 Pipeline, ISAC and Iowa County Engineer's Service Agency meetings last week.
