

BOARD MINUTES
AUGUST 30, 2021

The Keokuk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, Monday, August 30, 2021 in the Board Room of the Courthouse. Present were: Michael C. Hadley, Fred Snakenberg, Daryl Wood and Christy Bates, County Auditor.

8:30 a.m.-Meeting was called to order. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the agenda. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:35 a.m.- Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by Fred Snakenberg to approve the minutes of August 23, 2021 as submitted. Deke Wood seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.

8:40 a.m.-Discussion and approval of the FY 2020/2021 Annual Financial Report. Christy Bates distributed the report for review. Motion was made by Deke Wood to approve the report. Fred Snakenberg seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried. The report will be placed in the September 8th News-Review.

8:45 a.m.- Met with Andy McGuire, Engineer regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department. Andy discussed topics presented at the ISAC meetings last week, some of which correlate with local concerns, and informed the grinding on Lacey pavement was completed last week with painting of lines to take place today. Deke Wood received a call from a Meadowbrook resident requesting placement of speed limit signage due to speeding in said residential area where children are present. Consensus was to try to take care of it personally first.

9:50 a.m.-Various board and committee reports were held. Deke Wood attended 1015 Transit and Assessor's Conference Board meetings. Mike Hadley attended Area 15 and ISAC meetings. Fred Snakenberg did not attend meetings last week.

9:15 a.m.-Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. Christy Bates informed she is working on the American Rescue Plan Act interim report that is to establish a baseline and possible loss of revenue growth and forwarded the ICAP Cyber underwriting application, completed by Charles Kent, IT, to Paul Horak, insurance representative, for review.

There being no further business, motion to adjourn was made by Mike Hadley. All ayes and the meeting adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
