- 8:31 a.m. Review and approval of minutes of previous board meeting was held. Motion was made by <u>Fred Snakenberg</u> to approve the minutes of September 6, 2022 as submitted. <u>Deke Wood</u> seconded the motion. All ayes and motion carried.
- 8:45 a.m. Met with Engineer Andy McGuire regarding the Keokuk County Highway Department was held. Andy informed he received a call from the Tri-County School Transportation Director regarding the approximate 1.25 mile road closure, for regrading purposes, on 160<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Hwy 22 to inquire why he was not notified of said closure. Motion was made by <u>Deke Wood</u> to approve the 28E agreement as submitted. <u>Fred Snakenberg seconded</u> the motion. All ayes and motion carried.
- 9:15 a.m. Various Board and Committee reports was held. Fred Snakenberg participated in a Decat meeting. Neither Mike Hadley nor Deke Wood had scheduled meetings last week.
- 9:20 a.m.- Discussion of old/new business and public comment was held. The Kiwanis Club of Sigourney provided a pavilion progress update. Jeff Kiebel, Custodian, has a planned absence for a few days. We currently do not have a fill-in custodian, therefore, department heads will be responsible for their own office during this timeframe.
